AMENDMENTS TO RIGA PORT DUES AND CHARGES

The following amendments shall be introduced to Riga port Dues and Charges:

1. To provide formulation of the clause 28 as follows:

“28. Sanitary Dues for a ship shall be calculated separately for each call of a port. The Sanitary Due shall include reception of any waste and polluted water, except for polluted ballast water and tank washings. The Sanitary Due from passenger and cruise ships shall refer to the amount of discharged waste not exceeding 200 m³ during one call at the port.”

2. To provide formulation of the clause 32 as follows:

“32. Berthing Dues shall be collected for usage of any berth from all ships laying alongside for every case of using the berth or applying hourly rate for berth use in cases, defined by the p.36 of the present Regulations. The ship's unmooring from the berth and mooring it back to the same berth for ship loading purposes shall be considered a single case of using the berth.”
