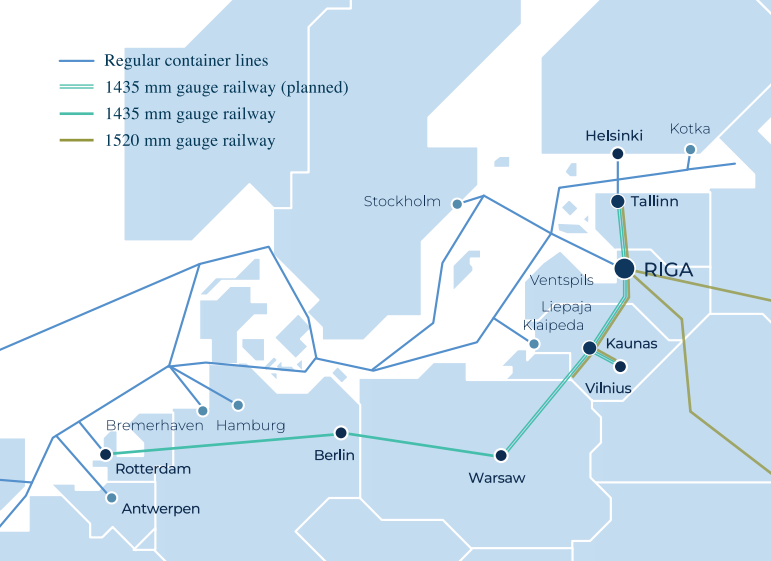

35 cargo handling terminals

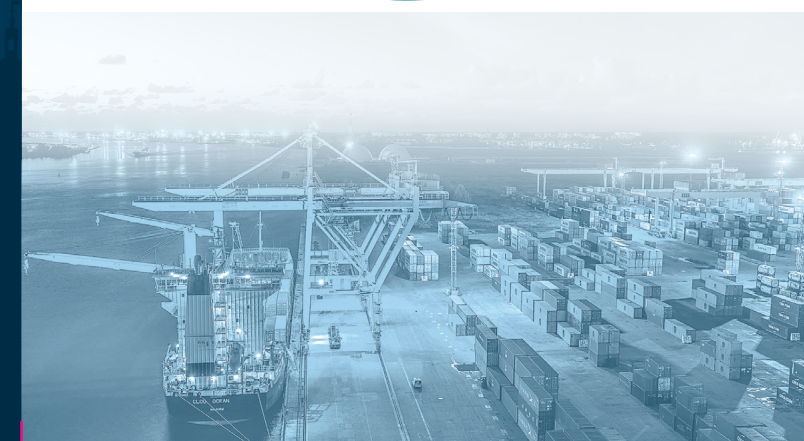
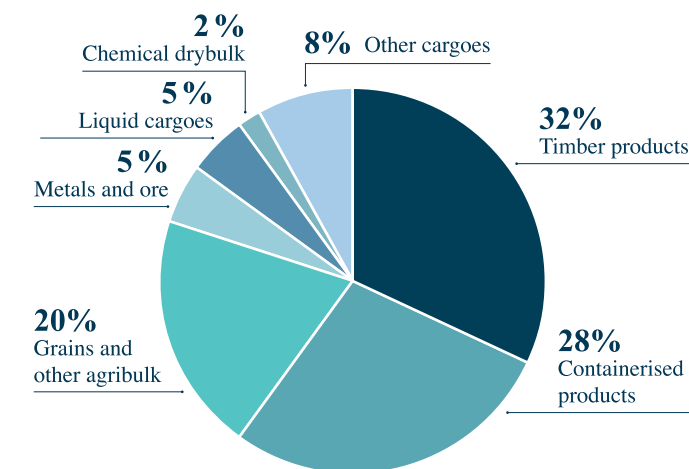
40 warehouses, including 18 customs warehouses
