Amendments to Port Dues and Charges of the Port of Riga

Issued in accordance with Section 13, Paragraph three
and Section 15, Paragraphs one and two of the Law on Ports

The amendments to Port Dues and Charges of the Port of Riga (approved by the decision of the Freeport of Riga Board No. 105 of 19 November 2020 (Min. No.16, p.1) with amendments approved by the Decision of the Freeport of Riga Board No. 18 of 23 December 2022 (Min. No.18, p.1), and amendments approved by Decision No.59 of 6 July 2023 (Min. No 13, p.6), and amendments approved by Decision No.27 of 22 March 2024 (Min. No 4, p.7) and amendments approved by Decision No.1 of 17 January 2025 (Min. No 1, p.6), shall be introduced as follows:

1. The paragraph 57 shall be amended as follows:

“57. The maximum permissible charge for the use of floating craft, which is not related to the performance of their basic functions, shall be calculated according to the following hourly rates:

57.1. for the use of floating craft and vessels (up to 125GT) for the transport of passengers/goods to or from vessels anchored at the port - 650 EUR/h;

57.2. for the use of ships for the elimination of the accident consequences - 980 EUR/h.”
2. Delete paragraph 59.
3. The paragraph 61 shall be amended as follows: “61. The maximum permissible charge for on-call duty of a vessel equipped with fire-fighting equipment shall be calculated at the rate of 980 EUR/h.”
4. The paragraph 62 shall be amended as follows:

“62. The maximum permissible charge for the reception of oily ship-generated waste (Annex I to the MARPOL Convention) to a specially equipped ship or road transport shall be set at 100 EUR/m³.”
5. The paragraph 63 shall be amended as follows:

“63. The maximum permissible charge for the reception of sewage (Annex IV to the MARPOL Convention) to a specially equipped ship or road transport shall be set at 65 EUR/m³.”

6. The paragraph 64 shall be amended as follows:

“64. The maximum permissible charge for the reception of waste/garbage (Annex V to the MARPOL Convention) shall be set at 95 EUR/m³.”

7. The paragraph 65 shall be amended as follows:

“65. The maximum permissible charge for the transfer of residues generated in the process of exhaust gas cleaning (with a Ph level of 6.8-7.2) (Annex VI to the MARPOL Convention) shall be set at 550 EUR/m³.”

8. The paragraph 67 shall be amended as follows:

“67. The maximum permissible charge for the supply of drinking water to a ship shall be calculated at a rate of EUR 5 EUR/m³, excluding costs for connection to the stationary equipment and use of motor vehicles or watercraft.”

Amendments to Port Dues and Charges of the Port of Riga shall come into force on 1 January 2026.
